



International Graduate Admissions Affidavit of Financial Support

The Department of Homeland Security requires F-1 students to show adequate and available funding for the first year of study and sufficient funding for subsequent years. Graduate students requesting an I-20 (F-1 Visa) for the 2023/24 school year should be able to demonstrate the ability to pay at least \$25,480 USD per year. **Please note that this amount is an estimate and is subject to change at any time.**

Although Edgewood College offers on-campus employment opportunities, it is necessary that each student evaluates the cost of attending Edgewood College and is prepared to finance it totally. Tuition and fees for each term must be paid in full prior to beginning classes.
