## FALL 2020 ENTERING FIRST YEAR, FULL-TIME (FYFT) FRESHMEN

- 1,295 applied, 1,181 accepted, 286 enrolled. Acceptance rate is 91.2%. Yield rate is 24.2%, including 83 men and 203 women.
- Average ACT score: Math 21.5, English 21.2, Reading 22.6, Science 22.7, composite 22.0.
- On average, students rank in the top 33% of their high school class, with an average high school GPA of 3.4

## FALL 2020 ENTERING FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME TRANSFER DEGREE-SEEKING STUDENTS

283 applied, 186 accepted, 103 enrolled. Enrolled students include 26 men and 77 women.

**Financial Aid** Among the **Fall 2019** cohort of full-time, first-time degree-seeking undergraduate students:

- 95.9% received institutional grants, such as scholarships and fellowships funded by Edgewood and individual departments.
- 41.1% received state grants & scholarships.
- 31.1% received federal grants such as Pell Grants and Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants.
- 68.9% received student loans.

*The average financial aid package is \$41,092 for first-time full-time freshmen.*
