FALL 2021 ENTERING FIRST YEAR, FULL-TIME (FYFT) FRESHMEN

- 1,194 applied, 1,142 accepted, 255 enrolled. Acceptance rate is 95.6%. Yield rate is 22.3%, including 93 men and 162 women.
- Average ACT score: Math 22.1, English 21.8, Reading 23.6, Science 23.0, composite 22.7.
- On average, students rank in the top 38% of their high school class, with an average high school GPA of 3.4.

FALL 2021 ENTERING FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME TRANSFER DEGREE-SEEKING STUDENTS

148 applied, 148 accepted, 74 enrolled. Enrolled students include 28 men and 46 women.

Financial Aid Among the **Fall 2020** cohort of full-time, first-time degree-seeking undergraduate students:

- 100% received institutional grants, such as scholarships and fellowships funded by Edgewood and individual departments.
- 39% received state grants & scholarships.
- 27% received federal grants such as Pell Grants and Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants.
- 90% received student loans.

The average financial aid package is \$27,239 for first-time full-time freshmen.
