

### FALL 2021 ENTERING FIRST YEAR, FULL-TIME (FYFT) FRESHMEN

• 1,194 applied, 1,142 accepted, 255 enrolled. Acceptance rate is 95.6%. Yield rate is 22.3%, including 93 men and 162 women.

• Average ACT score: Math 22.1, English 21.8, Reading 23.6, Science 23.0, composite 22.7. • On average, students rank in the top 38% of their high school class, with an average high school GPA of 3.4.
