- Three Undergraduate Certificates in Organizational Behavior and Leadership are available for learners who want to upgrade their leadership and management skills without committing to a full degree program. Each certificate is comprised of four courses.
- The Credit for Prior Learning Program is designed to help students earn credit for knowledge and skills learned through life and work experience. If you qualify, you'll have a head start in completing your degree even faster.
- Financial aid and transfer credits are available; our counselors can assist you in finding all the benefits you are eligible for.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. A detailed resume that demonstrates all work experience.
2. GPA: GPA: First time students must have earned a high school diploma with a GPA of 2.5 or a GED score of 278. Transfer students must have a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) in at least 12 academic credits from an accredited college.
3. A completed application. (\$30 application fee)
4. Official transcripts. Please request that official transcripts for all high school and undergraduate academic credits earned be sent to: Edgewood College, Attn: Admission Manager, 1000 Edgewood College Drive, Madison, WI 53711

Note: A requirement for completion of this program is a semester-long internship. Students who have relevant work experience can apply for a waiver to the internship.
